**Profile of Speaker****Minister Mari Elka Pangestu**

Dr. Pangestu is Minister of Trade of the Republic of Indonesia since October 2004. She is a member of the Network of Global Agenda Councils and the chair of Group 33 in the World Trade Organization. Prior to this, she was an adjunct professor at the Australian National University, a member of the Governing Board of the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Jakarta, and coordinator of the Task Force on Poverty and Development for the United Nations Millennium Project. Dr. Pangestu obtained her Bachelor and Master of Economics from the Australian National University and her Ph.D. in Economics from the University of California in Davis.
