ADB's support for trade facilitation

- ADB has supported trade facilitation over the years as a means to increase investment and trade
- Trade facilitation as a key component of ADB's subregional programs
- Since 1994, ADB has played been active in the evolution of these regional and subregional initiatives.
- ADB has promoted good practices in trade facilitation through a series of partnerships with other international organizations.

Previous studies about the benefits of trade facilitation

- No universal definition of trade facilitation.
- Reflecting the diversity of its definition, most studies differ in terms of what TF measures they cover.
- The methodology to measure the effects of TF also vary.
- Based on the studies surveyed, reported benefits from TF could be significant but quite varied.
- Going forward, there is a need to come up with a more standardized framework and to develop data sources that could be used to analyze TF benefits
