Dr Chaipat has extensive expertise in macroeconomics, policy analysis and research as well as international cooperation. His experiences from holding various positions at the Bank of Thailand during 2000 to 2013 cover domestic macroeconomic and external sector surveillance, regional economic cooperation, global economic assessment over the course of the global crisis, as well as reserves management strategies. Concurrently, he conducted a number of research projects that provided tangible policy implications in the areas of monetary and financial stability, external sustainability, regional financial integration and economic rebalancing. He also has pertinent experience at the multilateral level in a capacity of Senior Advisor to Executive Director of the Southeast Asia Voting Group at the IMF from 2011 to 2013 from overseeing country surveillance reviews together with significant policy reviews related to international monetary system, capital flow policies, international spillover, fiscal and debt sustainability and financial sector surveillance.

Dr Chaipat completed his Ph.D. study in Economics at the University of Pennsylvania. He also holds a master's degree from the University of Cambridge and a bachelor's degree (first-class honor) from Chulalongkorn University in Thailand.
