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


Estimated Micronesian Migrants by Place: 1995 to 2012




Micronesians Inside and Outside FSM: 2010 and 2012




Percent in Paid Employment by Receiving Area, Migrants: 2012

Percent Working in Private Sector by Area and Gender, Micronesian Migrants: 2012





Figure 2.12: Percent in Private Sector, FSM and Guam Migrants: 2010 and 2012

Figure 2.7: Remittances to FSM Housing Units by Place in 2011: 2012







