Mr. Bindu N. Lohani is Vice-President of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Knowledge Management and Sustainable Development and a member of the ADB's Management Team. He is responsible for ADB's Regional and Sustainable Development Department, Economics and Research Department (Office of the Chief Economist), Office of Regional Economic Integration, Regional and Sustainable Development Department (RSDD), and the Office of Information Systems and Technology.

Prior to assuming his current post, Mr. Lohani was Vice-President (Finance and Administration) of ADB. During his 25 years in the Bank, Mr. Lohani held several positions, including Director General of RSDD (responsible for sectoral and thematic areas like energy, water, transport, urban development, education, environment, gender and social development, and governance) concurrently Chief Compliance Officer, Special Advisor to the President on Clean Energy, Climate Change and Environment, The Secretary of the Bank, and Deputy Director General of Infrastructure Department and Office of Environment and Social Department. Before joining ADB, he worked for the Government of Nepal and was Division Chairman of the Environmental Engineering Program at the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT), Bangkok.

Dr. Lohani holds a Doctorate degree in Engineering. Dr. Lohani is a member of the National Academy of Engineering of United States, and is a diplomate of the American Academy of Environmental Engineers and Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science Council. Dr. Lohani served on the 18-member Blue Ribbon Committee for "Grand Challenges for Engineering for the 21st Century", an American National Science Foundation Project, to identify the world's greatest challenges and opportunities in the next century.
